

CHAPTER 20

CEMETERIES

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ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL.

Section 20.1 In General.

The City of Poulan being the owner and permanent caretaker of the Poulan Cemetery and the authorized grantor in deeds of conveyance of the cemetery plots therein, the Mayor and Council do order and ordain that upon such plots and burial sites in said cemetery the grantees and owners of said plots which have been conveyed by the Mayor and Council shall be authorized to place corner posts and slabs and monuments thereon, but no owner shall place upon such plots any planted shrubs or planted flowers, gravel, fences, copings, or any other like obstruction, structure, or plants which shall impede and obstruct the mowing and general maintenance of the Poulan Cemetery. Any such prohibited structure, plant, or obstruction so placed on said plots shall be subject to removal by the employees and agents of the Mayor and Council.

Section 20.2 Definition.

Domicile is defined as the place where a person has a true, fixed permanent home and principal establishment, and to which place such person, whenever absent, has the intention of returning, and from which he or she has no present intention of moving.

Section 20.3 Purchase of Lots-Cost; Execution of Documents.

a. The cost of a cemetery lot in the City of Poulan for an individual who has maintained domicile in the City of is a customer of the City water system but not domiciled in the City of Poulan is \$525.00. The total fees shall include the purchase of cornerstones with the purchasers requested last name initial engraved, and also includes the filing of said deed at the Worth County Court House and Poulan City Hall.

b. The cost of a cemetery lot in the City of Poulan for an individual not domiciled in the City of Poulan and not a customer of the City of Poulan water system is \$925.00. The total fees shall include the purchase of cornerstones with the purchasers requested last name initial engraved, and also includes the filing of said deed at the Worth County Court House and Poulan City Hall.

c. The Mayor or, in his absence, the Mayor Pro Tem and the City Clerk are authorized, pursuant to the authority granted in O.C.G.A. §36-37-6, to execute all documents necessary for the sale of lots from the City of Poulan Cemetery and to collect the sales price established in this article and deposit same in the City Treasury.
